## From Our Pastor

As I sit here writing this article, I am in awe of what an awesome God we serve. My first Sunday as the Pastor of Hollywood Baptist Church was September 11, 2005. I will have been here 13 years, if I make it to this September. It seems like just yesterday that I started as your pastor. God has done so much and I am so thankful for His great work and the amazing things that have taken place over the years. I will be eternally grateful for His leadership in my life to come here to pastor the people of Hollywood Baptist Church. It has been an exciting time as we have seen God's handiwork on many different levels.

In just a few short months, we will be reaching a "new milestone" as we open our brand new multipurpose facility. The grand opening date is scheduled for October 21. Things are moving right along as we prepare for that big day. The Lord has led us every step of the way since beginning this new building. What an awesome thing to see Him supply every need concerning this project. This building has been talked about for years and now we are seeing that vision unfold right before our very eyes. It will open up so many opportunities for ministry for us within our community.

All throughout the scripture God's people prayed and God supplied. Hudson Taylor once said, "God's work, done God's way, will never lack God's supply." On June 29, 1884, Hollywood Baptist Church was formally organized with 50 members. They dedicated their first place of worship and it has seen God's great hand of blessing ever since.

As I think about the future of Hollywood, I am greatly encouraged because of the faithfulness of a great number of people. Many of you have risen to the occasion over the years to take leadership rolls here in the ministry. You have sacrificed much and gone and given when it wasn't convenient, but you did it anyway. God has used so many different people in so many different ways. Some are still with us and some have been promoted to glory, however, the drive and motivation still remains the same. The vision and vitality has been so refreshing and inspiring to me as I have seen this ministry move forward in the 13 years I have been here. May we continue to see God's hand at work and may we continue to trust Him as our sustenance in life.




