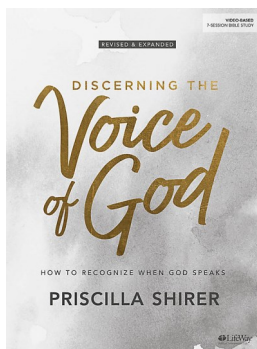

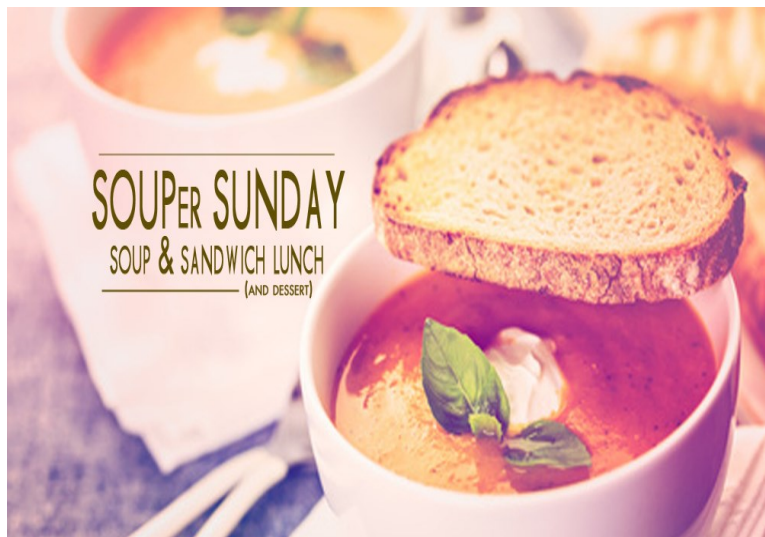

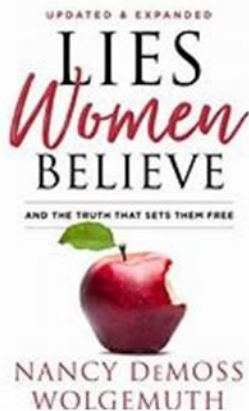


Paint Night in the Multipurpose Room of new building

From Our Associate Pastor of Youth and Music

I have always liked New Years. There is a sense of new beginnings, a fresh start, an exciting future. We get to put behind us the worries and problems of the previous year and look ahead to new and wonderful things. New Year's Resolutions are a big part of that process for many people. Starting with a clean slate allows us to dream big about what we want to accomplish in the coming year.

For those who are Followers of Jesus Christ, at some point in the past there was the most spectacular New Year ever. According to 2 Corinthians 5:17 (ESV) "If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come." Believers began with a new life, a clean slate, a fresh start, and an exciting future.

Like the annual New Year, this new beginning can also be a foundation for resolutions. And, no matter how far in the past your New Life is chronologically, it is never too late to resolve to live more for Christ. There is one big difference, however; for these resolutions we have the most dependable and powerful supporter there is...the Holy Spirit.

So what are some resolutions that one could make because of New Life in Christ?

Galatians 2:20 – I resolve to allow, and take full advantage of, the fact that Christ now lives in me. I will live daily by faith in the Son of God.

1 Corinthians 10:31 – I resolve to do everything that I do to the glory of God, to the advantage of others, so that they might be saved.

Ephesians 4:22 – I resolve to put off my old self, to set aside the sinful ways of my past, and put on my new self, righteous and holy, created in the likeness of God.

One of my first backpack camping trips was through mountains in the winter with inferior gear. I was poorly prepared and not in anywhere near the shape I should have been in to complete the trip. Although I finished, and I was glad that I went, the trip itself was miserable.

A year later I took a similar trip with quality gear. I had prepared myself physically and mentally and was in much better shape. I had a blast. It was still difficult, but I found that I was better able to handle the challenges and I had a much better time in spite of the difficulties.

The Christian walk is a hike through mountainous terrain, not a stroll through a lovely, flat, paved path. There are challenges to face, hills to climb, raging torrent to cross, and valleys to navigate. There are days of blessing and joy, and sometimes there are nights of gloom and despair.

A weak faith will not be able to navigate this path. Inferior gear will not get us through. Lack of preparation will leave us wondering if we are going to make it to the top of the next hill.

On the other hand, if we prepare ourselves by increasing our knowledge of Scripture through daily Bible study, if we equip ourselves with the Word of God and the faithful instruction and testimony of Godly men and women, if we exercise our faith by leaning on God in everything we do, our journey will be much more rewarding.

I challenge you to resolve to follow Christ more fully, trust God more completely, and know the Scripture more thoroughly. These resolutions will reward you beyond measure.
