



Dear Praying Friends and Partners in Christ,

We hope that this letter finds you rejoicing in the Goodness and Blessings of our Lord Jesus Christ. We are so Thankful for your Prayers for us each and every day.

A day and a half after Thanksgiving last November Rhonda took me to the hospital with much pain. Was examined and was told I had Pancreatitis and a inflamed gall bladder. Was admitted and after inflammation of gall bladder was down had surgery to remove it. After 8 days in the hospital and much grief was finally sent home. Had water in the lungs, high blood pressure issues, water on the heart and was told had heart failure and h-pillory. Spent the next couple of months recovering and doing a lot better at this time. That same week I was in the hospital Rhonda had to admit her dad, Ron Corley into a home because of his dementia worsening and harder to take care of him. She and her mom go in to visit with him each day...Please Pray for this situation as it had been very tough on Rhonda and her mom.

In December we finally got all the paper work done for taking over the mission here in Bloomfield that Rhonda's dad started years ago. We will lease the property for a year and after a year it will be turned over to us under Native Vision for Christ Navajo Ministries...We have been cleaning up the property and fixing, repairing much needed items (water lines, sewer lines, gas lines), as the property sat vacant for the last 10 - 12 years with no maintenance. We have had 2 Mission work teams in this year already to help with remodeling and cleanup. Got the old church floor re-tiled, repainted and have started Sunday morning services back up here in Bloomfield.

Through all that has gone on and is going on we know that God is in control of all things as that he has promised "He would never leave us nor forsake us" and he is guiding and leading us.

We are looking forward to a busy summer as we have Mission work teams lined up to help with projects here in Bloomfield. Also our Son, Taylon will be graduating high school here in a couple of weeks and starting college in Fall at Ft. Lewis College in Durango, CO. and Shasta will be starting high school in the fall.
