From Our Pastor

What do you think when you see a sign that says, "Do not place hand under mower while running?" It is usually in big bold letters located on the deck of a lawn mower which gives a great warning that could be life altering if neglected. There are many signs in life that we have a tendency to take for granted or in some cases pay NO attention to. For some unknown reason we think that is for everyone else but not me.

All throughout the scriptures God gives us some healthy *sign posts* if we will heed them. One that I would like to draw your attention to is the one that says in Hebrews 10:24-25, "And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching." I realize that everyone is extremely busy and especially in the summer months. Weddings, graduations, family get-togethers, holidays, cookouts, vacations.....etc. Understandable!! But the problem lies when we don't understand how easy it is to get pulled away. Once we miss one Sunday, then it becomes easy to miss two Sundays and the next thing you know you are not coming at all and you have formed a habit that will take you a long ways away from God's plan.

In this passage, Paul was dealing with people that were wavering in their consistency of fellowship with the local body of believers. Their fellowship had become about them instead of it being about others. Do you ever ask this question? Why do I go to church or why should I go to church? Most of the time, we come for what we can *get* instead of what we can give or contribute. The emphasis in this passage is not on what a believer gets from the assembly, but rather on what he/she can contribute to the assembly.

First of all, Paul says in verse 24, "Let us consider one another." He is talking about *mutual consideration*. I must put others first in my walk with the Lord. My reason for showing up should be for what I can do to be of help to my brothers and sisters in the Lord. For the last 32 years that has been my weekly prayer before I come to church. I want God to use me to be a blessing to someone else. Church cannot be about me but it must be about others.

Secondly, there should be *mutual concern*. Faithfulness in church attendance encourages others and provokes them to love and good works. The word *provoke* here in verse 24 is used in a good sense. It means to "stir up, or to call into activity for a worthy purpose." This verse is not saying when you come to church *provoke* yourself to love and good works. It is saying that when I come to church I should encourage my church family to love one another and encourage them in the work of the Lord.

Thirdly, there should be *mutual communion*. It is my responsibility not to abandon my fellow comrades in their service of the Lord. As a brother I should be in my place doing what I need to do to encourage others in the Lord. How can I do that if I am not in my place? It would be good to remember that apart from anything else, going to church is a good way to demonstrate where our loyalty lies. I am not only expressing my loyalty to God but I am also being loyal to those that I should love the most.

Paul expresses the importance, in verse 25, of making our *temple attendance* a priority in these last days. As we see these days approaching it should motivate us to take our responsibility more seriously. Remember this is a *sign post* that God is using to exhort us to take serious due to the very nature of the times. He is saying, as the *day* (His return) approaches we must be faithful to come to church with a heart to honor God but also a desire to be a blessing to those that we come in contact with.
