In 1881, a state missionary held a revival meeting here in the area and later reported that it was a promising field to start a church. By 1883 Rev. Marshall Reed had given up his job and devoted himself to start a work here among the folks of "the old holly woods."

On June 29, 1884, Hollywood Baptist Church was formally organized with 50 members and dedicated their first place of worship. The one room building was built on one acre of property donated by Mr. & Mrs. B. S. Grubb and the rest is history.

It is God's desire to see people saved and to see lives changed and enriched by the power of God. He wants to invade lives, homes, and families to see them changed that He might receive the greatest amount of glory and honor for His great work. There is no time to waste in this upside down world in which we are living in. The Bible says in Ephesians 5:16 "To redeem the time, because the days are evil." Now is the time to determine in our hearts that we are going to do what needs to be done to see the work of God go on. May we have the mentality of the people in Nehemiah's day when they said, "Let us rise up and build." If there is ever a time when God's people need to have that type of mentality, it is now.




