From Our Pastor

"Prepare for landing." These are the words that you hear as your plane is descending and preparing to land. These words are alerting you to the fact that there are some things that you need to give attention to before your plane makes it first contact with the runway. It is all preparation but it is extremely important in making sure you are kept safe during the landing.

As our church has voted to move forward in a building project there are some "essential preparations" that need to happen as we move into this phase.

One of the key elements of a successful building project is prayer. We must see God as our source as we follow His leadership. Dr. Jerry Falwell used to always say, "Nothing of eternal value will be accomplished apart from prayer." Every aspect of this project must be bathed in prayer. In Nehemiah chapter one, Nehemiah sought the face of God as he fasted and prayed to seek out the will of the Lord. Even as the will of God was determined Nehemiah stayed in direct contact with God to seek wisdom in how the project was to be carried out.

Secondly, there must be determined effort. There are some intentional things that we need to commit ourselves to in making this project a success. In the book of Nehemiah the people were committed to completion. There were times when they fought through discouragement as they worked with one hand and held a weapon in the other. So much time and effort has gone into this project already and we need to stay consistent until the keys are in our hands and the loan has been paid off. It must be a collective effort to make this happen. In the fourth chapter of the book of Nehemiah the word "repaired" appears 38 times. Over and over again the scripture gives us a lineup of who was involved in the process. They stepped up to the occasion, they sacrificed their ease and exposed themselves to great opposition but they saw the project through. The work does not stop here just because we approved for the building to be built. We must keep our hand to the plow and not look back.

Thirdly, we must keep our goal in view, keep our focus and stay on track. We must not allow anything to divert our attention away from our goal. There were times when the enemy tried to get the people off focus but they were determined to see it through. On several occasions Nehemiah was challenged to get his focus off but he determined that it was more important to give his attention to the priority at hand.

Fourthly, there must be enthusiasm. Zeal in one heart sets other hearts burning. Enthusiasm is caught not taught. What an exciting time in the life of our church! For years this project has been talked about and efforts have been made to make this a reality and after all this time it is finally unfolding right before our very eyes. What an answer to prayer!

During WW II, the soldiers would decorate their barracks at Christmas. They were fond of putting mottoes on the walls as you entered. In one room above the door, the motto was, "At peace, but still on duty" and another one read, "At rest, but ready." Are not these equally applicable to where we are as a church? We are in a time of "preparing for landing." There are some key elements that need our immediate attention to assure ourselves of a secure landing. Will you commit yourself to prayer on a daily basis for this project? Will you by God's grace do what you can do to make this project a success? Will you stay on tract and stay under the burden of this project until it is completed? Will you be excited in your heart and be a source of encouragement for those who wain at times in their enthusiasm? This is an opportunity for us to see something supernatural take place that we might not ever see again. Will you be an instrument in the hand of God in seeing His Kingdom extended?
